Safety Program

The district superintendent shall have overall responsibility for the current comprehensive safety program which will include, but not be limited to, compliance with and enforcement of all state and federal laws, rules and regulations. He/She may designate a safety officer for the district. All staff will be responsible to help maintain a safe and healthful environment. The safety officer will monitor all parts of the safety program, implement policies and objectives, interpret regulations, provide leadership and guidance to staff and report to the superintendent.

The district safety program shall include the district safety committee that meets regularly on a monthly basis and as needed. It shall be made up of one employee representing each employee classification including administration/confidential, classified, certified, and include all other interested employees. It shall be their responsibility to provide and oversee;

1. Administrative supervision and inspection of facilities to assure compliance with federal, state and local statutes pertaining to health and safety;
2. Safety training for employees to promote safe working practices;
3. Instruction and supervision of students to promote knowledge of and adherence to safety practices;
4. Training in first aid and emergency care of injured persons.

Notwithstanding any regulation requiring specific action, administrators shall take prompt action to correct any unsafe condition or circumstance that is brought to their attention.
