## Reporting of Hazards

Through routine inspection of all facilities, materials and equipment, as well as through staff training, all hazardous or potentially hazardous conditions will be identified, reported and acted upon appropriately.

The superintendent will develop and maintain a written hazard communication program for the district. All personnel who, during the performance of their duties, or in an emergency, may be exposed to hazardous chemicals will be informed and trained to deal appropriately with these chemicals. All employees will be trained to recognize and respond appropriately to the presence of hazardous chemicals.

A formal safety inspection of buildings and grounds is to be done once each quarter and at other times as needed throughout the year by the district safety officer. One copy of the inspection report is to be filed at the site and one copy is to be sent to the superintendent. Particular attention should be given to the following:

1. That approved safety devices are installed and ready for use;
2. That emergency measures are defined and posted;
3. That warning notices are posted where needed.
