Student Transportation Services

School transportation services will be provided for students to and from school and for transporting students to and from curricular and extracurricular activities sponsored by the district.

These services shall be provided throughout the regularly scheduled year and during the regular school day as determined by the superintendent.

Transportation to school shall be provided to students living within specified attendance boundaries. In addition, students, including those receiving special education, may be eligible for transportation for health or safety reasons.

Miles from school will be determined in accordance with OAR 581-023-0040 (1)(c).

Transportation may be provided for resident students who have received approval to attend an out-of-district or out-of-attendance-area school.

Students attending any private, parochial or public charter school under the compulsory school attendance laws will, where the private, parochial or public charter school is along or near the bus route, be provided equally the riding privileges given to public school students.

School buses carrying students will be considered extensions of the school experience. All students using school transportation will abide by the code of conduct posted in each school bus or school activity vehicle. Violations of such code, as well as other conduct which is improper or which jeopardizes the safety of self or others, will be reported by the vehicle driver to the appropriate person. Violators may be denied use of transportation for a period of time as deemed proper.

The vehicle driver will be responsible for the vehicle at all times from departure until return. The driver will not participate in any activities that might impair his/her driving abilities.

The superintendent or designee shall ensure transportation officials and drivers receive notification of students having special medical or behavioral protocols identified in student records.

Information and/or training, including confidentiality requirements, will be provided to drivers, as appropriate.

The district will comply with all state and federal laws and regulations pertaining to school bus transportation.
