## Substance Abuse Program - Students\*\*

The Board recognizes that students have a right to attend school in an environment conducive to learning. Since student use of alcohol and other mind-altering drugs is illegal and harmful and interferes with the learning process, the school has a fundamental legal and ethical obligation to prevent unlawful drug, alcohol and tobacco use and to maintain a drug-free educational environment.

The district is committed to a comprehensive home-school-community partnership supported program which includes as essential components: prevention, intervention, discipline, community treatment, referral and aftercare. The district will continuously develop and maintain K-12 programs in prevention, intervention and school reentry support. Professional treatment and aftercare, when needed, will remain the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian. The district is committed to cooperation during treatment and aftercare.
