 - b. Arranging for staff development necessary to the establishment and operation of learning programs that better meet more learner needs;
 - c. Coordinating cooperative efforts at improvement of learning programs, facilities, equipment, and materials; and
 - d. Providing access to the decision-making process for the ideas of staff, students, parents and others.
2. To manage the district's various facilities, funds and programs effectively;
3. To provide professional advice and counsel to the Board and to any committees established by Board action.
