Title VII: Native American Education Program Grant

The district may participate with Confederated Tribes of Umatilla Indian Reservation (CTUIR) in submitting a Title VII grant application for the purpose of receiving federal funds to support Native American Education Program efforts.

The CTUIR Title VII application should include a comprehensive program for meeting the language and cultural needs of Indian children. Programs and activities will be consistent with, and promote state and local improvement plans under applicable provision of Title III of Goals 2000: Educate America Act.

The CTUIR Title VII program shall be developed in consultation with a CTUIR advisory committee consisting of parents of Indian children and teachers, and when appropriate, Indian students at the secondary level. A majority of committee members shall be parents of Indian children.

The input of committee members and representatives of the area to be served shall be solicited in the hiring of Title VII program personnel charged with program over-site responsibilities and in subsequent program operation and evaluation.

The progress of the Indian children will be assessed periodically in accordance with grant application requirements. Results will be reported to the Tribal Education Department.
