

Admission of Exchange Students

Foreign students will be accepted in district schools without payment of tuition for a period of one year for each student provided that the following conditions are met:

1. The student has in possession a passport issued by the student's own government and a United States J-1 Visa.
2. The student is sponsored through an international youth exchange program recognized by and meeting the criteria established by the Oregon International Council.
 - a. The program will be responsible for conducting an orientation for the foreign student prior to starting school and have available a representative for consultation.
3. Two weeks prior to enrolling extensive information on the student's background, interests, academic performance, and language ability to provided the school.
4. Advance agreement and approval has been reached with the school.
5. A citizen of the district agrees to accept responsibility for such student.
6. The student speaks, reads, and writes English reasonably well.
7. The student has documentation and filed with the school, the required record of immunization that satisfies Oregon's Comprehensive School Immunization Law.
8. No more than two students from any given country or language group are enrolled at the same time.
9. Regular student fees are paid.

Foreign students will be accepted in district schools with payment of nonresident tuition rates provided that the following conditions are met.

1. The student has in possession a passport issued by the student's own government and a United States F-1 Visa.
2. Two weeks prior to enrolling, extensive information on the student's background, interests, academic performance, and language ability be provided the school.
3. The student speaks, reads and writes English reasonable well.

4. The student has documentation and filed with the school the required record of immunization that satisfies Oregon's Comprehensive School Immunization Law.
5. Regular student fees are paid.
6. Documents of full responsibility for supervision, academic progress, guardianship, and district residency is assumed by a citizen of the district. The district will not bear these responsibilities.
