Student Withdrawal from School

Students identified by the staff as potential or immediate dropouts will be encouraged to attend school for a three-day assessment period (as appropriate) after they have indicated their intention of leaving school. During this three-day period the following procedure is to be implemented:

1. Student, counselor, parents and principal will meet to discuss reasons for leaving school and student's future plans.
2. Regular school program should be modified to suit student's needs on a part-time basis if possible. Student should be made aware of educational and occupational alternatives per policy IGBHC – Alternative Education Notification.
3. If a student withdraws, there shall be an effort to keep the amount of discomfort minimal for the student to re-enroll at a later date.
4. Student, parents, counselor and principal will review all pertinent information and give their recommendations.
5. If possible, students who withdraw shall be contacted after a 10 day period to re-evaluate their decision.

Additionally, the district may notify the Oregon Department of Transportation of the withdrawal from school of a student who is at least 15 years of age and under 18 years of age as provided by ORS 339.257 and Board policy JHFDA - Suspension of Driving Privileges.
