Assessment Program**

The district's testing program will be conducted in accordance with the following:

1. Each year the district shall determine the student's progress toward achieving the standards at grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11;
2. Progress shall be measured in a manner that clearly enables the student and parents to know whether the student is making progress toward meeting or exceeding standards;
3. The results of such assessments shall be used to measure the academic content standards. The results will also be used as a basis for planning learning activities and as a factor in determining the success of school programs;
4. The district shall make additional services or alternative educational or public school options available to any student who has not met or has exceeded all of the standards;
5. The district shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for assessment, evaluating and counseling students on the basis of race, national origin, religion, sex, age, disability or marital status. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures;
6. Staff will receive in-service education in the use of designated assessments and interpretation of assessment results;
7. A periodic review and evaluation of the district's assessment program will be conducted.
