Suspension**

The Board authorizes student suspension for one or more of the following reasons:

1. Willful violation of school regulations;
2. Willful conduct which materially and substantially disrupts the rights of others to an education;
3. Willful conduct which endangers the student, other students or staff members;
4. Willful conduct which endangers school property.

Suspension temporarily takes away the privilege of attending school or school activities from a student for a period not to exceed 10 school days. In special circumstances, a suspension may be continued until some specific pending action occurs, such as a court hearing, a physical or mental examination, an expulsion hearing or incarceration by court action. Suspensions are made by the principal or assistant principal with authority of the principal, and are not to be used in lieu of an expulsion.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations as necessary to implement this policy.
