

## Facilities Planning

It is the responsibility of the Board of Education to develop and implement plans for the district that will meet the educational requirements of the community both today and into the future. For this reason, the Board will see that a long-range building plan is in place. The following objectives shall be used in the development of this plan:

1. Facilities that are as nearly equal as possible in educational effectiveness shall be provided for all the students in the district.
2. Facilities shall be kept up to date by renovation, remodeling and/or additions, as necessary, e.g., classrooms, libraries, physical education facilities, etc.
3. Facilities shall strike the best possible balance among educational effectiveness, financial investment, efficient management and operation and community values concerning education.
4. Future growth of the district must be provided for by acquisition of sites well in advance of needs.

The Board will utilize a broad base of patrons, staff and consultants in the development of this plan. Such plan will be reviewed and updated every two years in order to meet changing needs.
