## Bond Campaigns

The Board will provide the public with information on school building needs, but it may not use district funds to advocate “yes” votes on bond issues.

As the need for bond issue support arises, a citizens’ committee may be encouraged to form for the purpose of promoting the passage of the bond issue and collecting funds needed for such promotion. Further support for bonding campaigns should accrue from the activities of the long-range planning committee described in Board policy FB - Facilities Planning.
