

Naming New Facilities

Insofar as possible, the Board will name an elementary school after the name of the geographic section which it serves. If the school is not to be named for the section that it serves, a representative group of parents will be consulted in naming the school.

In naming a school, the Board will receive name suggestions from the community, and the Board will make the final selection based as much as possible upon the following guidelines:

1. The name should be easily identifiable with the school;
2. The name should avoid confusion with the names of other schools or institutions, street names, or other geographic features;
3. If possible, the name should be selected on a geographical basis, but most important, it should have significance for the students who will attend the school; and
4. The names of people, particularly living people, should be avoided.
