

## **Curriculum Research and Pilot Projects**

The Board encourages the administration and staff to investigate and develop ideas, methods and curricula that may improve the educational programs of the District.

Experimental programs and pilot projects and the methods by which they are to be evaluated must be approved by the Board prior to implementation. Approval shall specify the period of time and the number of students to be involved in such programs and projects.

The Superintendent shall submit to the Board a status report and evaluation of experimental programs or pilot projects at least once a year.
