

Basic Instructional Program

The District shall have a planned program in reading, writing and mathematics at all school levels. Students K-8 shall receive instruction in art, health education, language arts, mathematics, music, physical education, science, social studies, and career education.

The high school shall provide an instructional program designed to allow students to meet District and State requirements for graduation.

The Superintendent or designee may excuse a student from specific programs or activities to accommodate the student's disability or belief.
