

Bilingual Instruction

All students whose primary language is other than English may be provided instructional assistance until they are able to use the English language in a manner that allows effective and relevant participation in regular classroom instruction and other educational activities.

Parents whose primary language is other than English and who are not able to use the English language in a manner that allows effective and relevant participation in educational planning for their child shall be provided with written or verbal communication in a language they can understand.
