

Homebound Instruction

The District may provide a home teacher to instruct pupils confined to their home because of illness, condition of disability, or action of the school authorities. Upon recommendation of the Superintendent, a home teacher may be provided as soon as possible in cases where a pupil is to be absent for longer than two weeks. The Superintendent may confer with the student's physician, the building principal and other appropriate staff in determining the needs for homebound instruction.

Students with chronic illness that causes repeated absence from school may be provided homebound instruction upon recommendation of the Superintendent.
