

Home Schooling

It is the policy of the Phoenix-Talent School District Board to recognize the rights of parents to educate students at home. It is the responsibility of the parent to contact the Education Service District to register child as being home schooled. Home schooling is subject to all applicable Oregon Revised Statutes and Oregon Administrative Rules.

The District wishes to assist in ways that will not materially detract from the educational resources and opportunities available to regularly enrolled students.

ADMINISTRATIVE RULES/REGULATIONS:

Dual Enrollment

1. The District provides for dual or concurrent enrollment and participation in co-curricular activities to those students not regularly enrolled in a public school program.

Dual enrollment is subject to the following conditions:
 - a) Concurrent, part-time enrollment is permitted on a space available basis;
 - b) Special transportation is not provided by the District;
 - c) Students are subject to the same attendance policies, rules, and regulations as regular students;
 - d) Participation in co-curricular activities is subject to the ORS, OAR'S, OSAA rules, District policies, and coaches' handbook;
 - e) Students are subject to the same standards of behavior as are regular students;
 - f) Instructional materials, such as books and curriculum guides, may be purchased at cost; library privileges are permitted upon payment of a \$20 refundable deposit;
 - g) The placement of returning students is subject to the same requirements as for regular students.
2. The District will not grant high school credit or diplomas to home-schooled students who reside within the District. Parents who elect home-schooling options are encouraged to pursue GED or community college diploma alternatives.
3. The District will cooperate with home-schooling parents in administering state tests and other standardized tests given to all regularly enrolled students. Parents are responsible to notify the District if they are interested in having their children tested. These tests do not meet the requirement put on parents by ORS and OAR to have their children tested annually, but they may assist parents in the education of their children by giving valuable feedback on progress.

4. The District may provide, if required, designated services to students who qualify for special education.
