

Community Funded Extra-curricular Activities

Phoenix-Talent School District #4 may, at the discretion of the Board of Directors, enter into agreements with community organizations, groups, and/or individuals requesting to provide extra-curricular activities for students.

Procedural Regulations:

1. The Board reserves the right to approve all coaching personnel.
2. The community organization will notify the Board in writing of its intent to finance the activity one year in advance and/or meet the calendar requirements of the Oregon School Activities Association and/or the Skyline League. This requirement may be waived by the Board.
3. A written contract will be required which specifies the terms and conditions of each agreement.
4. All sponsoring groups must have Board approval before activities begin.
5. If the sport is discontinued, all equipment that is the property of the District shall be returned.
6. All activities will be governed by the OSAA, Skyline Conference, coaches' handbook, and District policies.
7. Community organizations are responsible to and subject to the directions of the Athletic Director.
8. Liability insurance coverage subject to approval by the Board.
