

Daily Class Load

In accordance with Board Policy IHB, when adequate educational funding is available, the following guidelines should be followed as closely as judiciously possible:

1. In the elementary schools the average class-load within a school in grades kindergarten, one, two and three should not exceed 25 pupils (ADM).
2. The class load average within a school in grades four, five, six, seven and eight should not exceed a maximum of 30 pupils.
3. The class load for a teacher assigned to teach two grades should not exceed a maximum of 25 students.
4. In the high school and middle school, which are organized on a departmentalized or semi-departmentalized basis, the number of standardized classes instructed or supervised by a teacher should not exceed six in a seven-period day and seven in an eight- period day.
5. The number of student hours of instruction assigned to a teacher should not exceed an average of 160 per day.
6. Music and physical education may exceed the stipulated number of students.
