A report to parents indicating student progress toward meeting the State and District standards shall be made on a regular basis. Reporting may be made by progress report or student/teacher/parent conference.

Parents will be informed in a manner that clearly enables them to know whether their child is making progress toward meeting the standards. If a student's progress requires special consideration, parents will be notified in a timely manner.

The Board will periodically review the reporting system of the District to assure its effectiveness.
