

### **Mandatory Immunization for Admission**

Prior to and as a condition of his/her initial enrollment in the District, every child through grade 12 shall submit to the school principal one or more of the following statements:

1. A certificate of immunization status form completed and signed by the parent certifying that the child has received immunizations against communicable diseases pursuant to the rules of the Health Division; or
2. A statement signed by the parent, a physician or a representative of the local health department that describes the manner in which the child has begun the immunization process; or
3. A statement signed by a physician or a representative of the local health department that the child should be exempt from receiving specified immunizations because of an indicated medical diagnosis; or
4. A statement signed by the parent that the child has not been immunized because the child is being reared as an adherent to a religion the teachings of which are opposed to such immunization; or
5. A statement signed by the parent of a child transferring to a school from another school district that he/she will have the necessary immunization records sent to the school within 30 days of the initial enrollment of the child or that they will arrange to have the necessary immunizations initiated by a physician or local health department within 30 days.

Students who fail to meet the above requirements shall be excluded from school until the student complies with the law.

Principals may not enroll any pupil who has not complied with one of the foregoing requirements.
