

Suspension

The Board authorizes student suspension for one or more of the following reasons:

1. Willful violation of school regulations;
2. Willful conduct that materially and substantially disrupts the rights of others to an education;
3. Willful conduct that endangers the student, other students or staff members;
4. Willful conduct that endangers or damages school property.
5. Willful disobedience, open defiance of authority, or use of profane or obscene language.

Each suspension will include a statement of the reasons for suspension, the length of the suspension and a plan for readmission. No suspension shall extend beyond ten school days. The District may require a student to attend school during non-school hours as an alternative to suspension. Every reasonable and prompt effort must be made to notify the parents of suspended students.

Students who are suspended may not attend after-school activities and athletic events, be present on District property without a parent, or participate in activities directed or sponsored by the District.
