Foreign Exchange Students**

The district will limit the number of foreign exchange students attending school at any one time to four foreign exchange students. In an attempt to be fair to the exchange programs placing students in the Pilot Rock High School, (AIFS, PACE, AISE, AYUSA, ERDT/Share and Rotary International) enrollment will be limited to one student on a first-come/first-serve basis. If by August 1st, any of these programs haven't notified the administration of their intentions of placing an exchange student in the school, that position will be open by lottery for any of the programs who has more than one student to place.

Other foreign exchange programs may be considered upon their timely application for review by the Board and administration. Application for permission to participate must be filed with the superintendent's office at least one month in advance of any anticipated student placement.

The district administration should be notified by July 15th, in writing of the intentions of any foreign exchange program to place a student in our school. At that time the exchange program can pick up an information sheet of the items needed to be completed before registration of the foreign exchange student can take place.
