Reporting of Hazards

Through routine inspection of all facilities, materials and equipment, as well as through training of staff, it is expected that all hazardous or potentially hazardous conditions will be identified, reported and corrected.

The district will select a hazard communication officer who will develop and maintain a written hazard communication program for the district. All personnel who, during the performance of their duties or in an emergency, may be exposed to hazardous chemicals will be so informed and will be trained to deal appropriately with these chemicals. All employees will be trained to recognize and respond appropriately to the hazardous chemicals they are likely to encounter.
