## **Homebound Instruction**

Home or hospital instruction will be provided for any student of school age who is unable to attend school because of a physical disability and can profit from the service.

The student must, however, have a signed statement from the examining physician that qualifies that student under one of the following provisions:

1. Certified cases (partially reimbursed by the Oregon Department of Education):
  - a. A disabling or chronically ill condition that is permanent;
  - b. A disabling or chronically ill condition that has continued for a period of 10 consecutive school days.
  
2. Noncertified cases (district supported):
  - a. A physical disability or an illness that has extended continuously for a period of 10 school days.

Homebound instruction will not normally be furnished for those students excluded from school because of behavior problems.
