**School Admissions**

The Board is committed to providing an educational program for all students living in the district. The Board believes all students living in the district who have not completed 12 years of education should attend school regularly and be included in the available educational programs.

State law requires students to be age 6 on or before September 1 to enter first grade, and age 5 on or before September 1 to enter kindergarten.

All new students must register in the school office. Registration requirements include proof of the student's birth date (a birth certificate, a hospital record or a baptismal record) immunization records as required by law and permission to request previous school records. Students admitted to any grade must show evidence of completing the prior school years or demonstrate successful completion of outcomes required for course completion. Grade placement will be determined by the district.

The district will accept transfer work leading toward graduation, the Certificate of Initial Mastery or the Certificate of Advanced Mastery according to the following guidelines:

1. Accepts credits and attendance completed in standard Oregon schools;
2. Accepts credits and attendance completed in standard secondary schools for out-of-state students;
3. Accepts credits or recognition of prior experience from private, alternative or nonstandard public secondary schools only if the school is accredited by the Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges;
4. Determine the value of credits obtained through correspondence courses only from programs officially approved by the Oregon Department of Education;
5. Provide district-developed credit by demonstration options for students entering from home-schooled programs;
6. Determine the value of credits obtained in approved community college programs in meeting graduation requirements.

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission solely because the student does not have a fixed place of residence or solely because the student is not under the supervision of a parent.
