

District Educational Programs for Native American Impact Aids Funds

In order to meet the requirements of the Impact Aid statutes (20 U.S.C. Sections 7701-7714), the district will maintain or establish the following procedures:

1. To ensure the equal participation of Indian children in the educational program of the district, the district will provide adequate district staff to carry out planning and program development activities;
2. The district will convene and conduct a special meeting annually, open to the public, to discuss the Impact Aid application prior to its submission.

The purpose of this meeting shall be:

- a. To make recommendations concerning the needs and equal participation of their children in the entire educational program; and
 - b. To determine ways by which they can assist their children in realizing the benefits to be derived from the educational programs assisted by Impact Aid funds.
3. The district will advertise the location and time of all meetings in the local newspaper and in the district newsletter;
 4. Unresolved issues may be resolved under district regular complaint procedures or intergovernmental agreement, when appropriate.
