## Reporting of Hazards

Through routine inspection of all facilities, materials and equipment as well as through the training of staff, it is expected that all hazardous or potentially hazardous conditions will be identified, reported and corrected.

The superintendent will develop and maintain a written hazard communication program for the district. All personnel who during the performance of their duties or in a foreseeable emergency may be exposed to hazardous chemicals will be so informed and trained to deal appropriately with those chemicals. All individuals will receive hazardous material training prior to beginning employment with the district.

Materials and chemicals will be used in a manner which promotes the district concern for safety in the work place and for students in the educational program.
