

Safe Transportation on Buses

1. Bus drivers are instructed that if, in their opinion, a bus is unsafe to operate, they are not to drive it and are to so inform the transportation supervisor or the mechanic-in-charge.
2. It is also the responsibility of the driver, according to the *Oregon Pupil Transportation Manual*, Page 50 (7)(k), to see that emergency equipment, such as reflectors, etc., are in the bus and operable at all times.
3. Bus drivers are responsible for the safety of passengers on the school bus.
