

Selection of Issues and Instructional Materials

The issues and materials selected for study should make a positive contribution to the education of students.

The following criteria shall be used:

1. Are the issues/materials within the maturity level of the pupils?
2. Are the issues/materials of interest to the pupils?
3. Are the issue/materials socially significant and timely for this course and grade level?
4. Are the issues/materials those which the teacher feels he/she can handle successfully from a personal standpoint?
5. Are the issues/materials those for which adequate study material can be obtained?
6. Are the issues/materials those for which there is adequate time to justify the presentation?
7. Are the issues/materials those which will correspond to community customs and attitudes?
