

Alternative Education

The Rainier School District #13 shall provide information regarding alternative instructional programs and counseling service to parents, legal guardians or persons in parental relationship and to students who are to be expelled:

1. Have had a second or subsequent occurrence within any three-year period of severe disciplinary problem.
2. Has an attendance pattern so erratic that the student is not benefitting from the educational program.
3. Are 16 years of age or older and who have informed the district with a written notice of their intent to withdraw from school for reasons than to enroll in another school.

The principal or his designee shall inform the parent and the student of alternative instructional programs and of the counseling services available in the area and shall maintain a written record of the information so provided.
