

**Identification – Talented and Gifted Students among Nontypical Populations\*\***

The district will make an effort to identify talented and gifted students from special populations such as:

1. Cultural and ethnic minorities;
2. Disadvantaged;
3. Underachieving gifted; and
4. Students with disabilities.

Careful selection of appropriate measures and a collection of behavioral or learning characteristics shall be used to identify talented and gifted students.

Parents must follow the established an appeals process if they are dissatisfied with the identification process of their student for the district program for talented and gifted students and wish to request reconsideration.
