

## Graduation Exercises

Students who complete the following programs in a timely fashion, as described in Board policy IKFB, will have the opportunity to go through graduation exercises and receive a diploma.

1. Rainier High School (RHS) course work to meet district requirements.
2. RHS and/or college dual credit courses which assist in meeting graduation requirements.
3. RHS Alternative School programs which assist in meeting graduation requirements.
4. Brigham Young Home Study Program.

Students who transfer to RHS, prior to the start of the second semester of the senior year, and whose accepted and/or earned credits meet Rainier School Graduation Requirements, including if necessary those credits earned in the second semester, may receive a Rainier High School diploma and may go through graduation exercises.

Students who begin attending Rainier High School after the start of the second semester of the senior year, and who, by the end of the senior year, meet the graduation requirements of their previous school will receive the diploma of the previous district school.

They may go through RHS graduation exercises to receive that diploma if they choose.

Students who begin attending RHS after the second semester of the senior year and who do not meet the graduation requirements of the previous school district, will not receive a RHS diploma, nor will they be allowed to go through graduation exercises, even if they meet RHS graduation requirements.

When students fail to meet the graduation requirements of their previous district and move to RHS to take advantage of lower requirements, the Rainier School District will not recognize them by granting diplomas and allowing them the privilege of participation in graduation exercises. The district will not participate in celebrating graduation for people who try to escape their failure elsewhere.
