

Student Fees, Fines and Charges

1. The student's parents shall be given written notice of the intent to withhold records or deny participation in graduation ceremonies or both at least 10 days in advance of the actual withholding or denial. Notice shall include itemization of outstanding charges;
2. The parents may request a hearing during the 10 days in advance of the withholding or denial. A disposition decision must be made and given to the parents prior to the actual withholding/denial;
3. The principal may grant the parent's request to substitute work for an amount owed.
 - a. Either the student or the parent may perform the work
 - b. The principal will design the tasks keeping in mind the age and/or skill level of the worker.
 - c. Compensation will be the equivalent of minimum wage.
 - d. Work will be rounded up to the nearest one-half hour.
 - e. The principal has the option of refusing to use the student's labor as compensation when the student's labor would not provide equivalent value.
4. Money owed to the cafeteria is not included in this provision.
