Assignment of Students to Community Schools

Capacity at each middle level program (grades 6, 7 and 8) at Tumalo and Terrebonne Community Schools will be established by March 1 for the following school year. In order to provide equal opportunities for students and parents wishing to attend the community school middle level programs, application for 6th grade will be considered according to the following priorities:

- First Priority: Fifth grade students currently residing within the community school attendance boundary with a sibling currently attending the middle level program at that school.
- Second Priority: Fifth grade students currently residing within the community school attendance area.
- Third Priority: Fifth grade resident students from other Redmond schools.
- Fourth Priority: Fifth grade resident students from another district.

Lottery Process

In the event that applications for a grade level in the community school middle level program exceed the established capacity levels, each student applicant will be assigned a randomly generated number and weighed per the priorities listed above.

The lottery process is only for the initial assignment of 6th grade students. Once students have been admitted to the middle level program of a community school they do not have to participate in a lottery for the 7th and 8th grades.

Applications for community school middle level programs will be due by April 1 each year. Parents/Guardians will be notified of lottery drawing results by May 1.
