Student Vehicle Use

Private owned motor vehicles may be operated by students on school premises subject to the following :

1. All school rules and local and state traffic laws must be followed when operating vehicles on school premises;
2. All such vehicles driven to school must be registered with the school administration. All nonregistered cars may be towed;
3. No student will be permitted to leave the school grounds during school hours without the permission of the school administration;
4. Student vehicles are to be considered “off limits” during the school day unless specific permission has been granted by the administration;
5. No transportation on school grounds of students in the back of trucks unless in seat belts. A violation of this rule can forfeit individual parking privileges for the remainder of school year.

All students who drive motor vehicles to school are subject to parking and driving rules in this policy. All students parking on district property on a regular basis must show evidence:

1. That the student driving the vehicle holds a valid driver’s license;
2. That the vehicle is currently registered;
3. That the vehicle the student is driving is insured under a motor vehicle liability insurance policy or other satisfactory proof of compliance with the financial responsibility requirements of the state.

Parking privileges will be subject to the specific requirements of this policy and any other applicable policy and/or rules of the district. Parking privileges, including driving on district property, may be revoked by the principal or designee for violations of Board policies, administrative regulations or school rules.

The district will post appropriate parking signs. No middle school student may drive to school or park in the school lot.
