## **Public Conduct on District Property**

No person on school property will:

1. Injure or threaten to injure another, verbally abuse, harass or bully;
2. Damage the property of another or of the district;
3. Initiate or circulate a report, one knows to be false, concerning an alleged hazardous substance, impending fire, explosion, catastrophe or other emergency that will take place in or upon a school;
4. Violate parking regulations;
5. Drive a vehicle in an unsafe manner;
6. Operate an unmanned aircraft system (UAS) or drone unless granted permission from the superintendent or designee;
7. Impede, delay or otherwise interfere with the orderly conduct of the district's educational program or any other activity taking place on district property which has been authorized by the Board, superintendent, principal, other authorized administrator or personnel;
8. Enter any portion of school premises at any time for purposes other than those which are lawful and authorized by school officials;
9. Smoke, use or distribute tobacco products or inhalant delivery systems;
10. Possess, consume, sell, give or deliver unlawful drugs including drug paraphernalia and alcoholic beverages;
11. Bring, possess, conceal or use a weapon as prohibited in federal and state law and district policy JFCJ - Weapons in the Schools;
12. Wear, possess, use, distribute, display or sell any clothing, jewelry, emblem, badge, symbol, sign or other item that is evidence of membership or affiliation with any gang. Use speech or commit any act or omission in furtherance of the interests of any gang or gang activity. A "gang" is defined as a group that identifies itself through the use of a name, unique appearance or language including hand signs, claiming of geographical territory or the espousing of a distinctive belief system that frequently results in criminal activity;

13. Willfully violate other rules and regulations adopted by the Board designed to maintain public order on school property.

Persons having no legitimate purpose or business on school property or those violating or threatening to violate the above rules may be issued a trespass citation, asked to leave the premises and/or referred to law enforcement officials.
