

## Use of Public Charter School Activity Vehicles for Student Transportation

The public charter school board may provide for the use of vehicles, commonly designated as Types 10, 20 or 21 pupil transportation vehicles, which do not meet the requirements of a “school bus” for the purpose of transporting students, licensed, nonlicensed or other supervisory personnel to and from curricular and extracurricular activities sponsored by the public charter school.

The vehicle shall be insured for bodily injury, property damage, uninsured motorist coverage and personal injury protection. The public charter school administrator will recommend amounts to adequately protect the public charter school against loss.

The public charter school will meet or exceed minimum driver requirements and procedures as set forth in Oregon Administrative Rules, Section 53. The public charter school shall meet child safety system requirements and minimum standards and specifications as set forth in state law.
