Talented and Gifted Program

The board is committed to an educational program that recognizes, identifies and serves the unique needs of talented and gifted students. Talented and gifted students are those who have been identified as academically talented and/or intellectually gifted.

The board directs the district staff to develop procedures for identifying academically talented and intellectually gifted students K-12. The board further directs the superintendent to develop a written plan that identifies programs or services needed to address the assessed levels of learning and accelerated rates of learning of identified students. All policies and procedures will be maintained in a district talented and gifted handbook.

The board has established a complaints procedure to utilize if an individual has a complaint regarding the appropriateness of programs and services provided for identified talented and gifted students. See board policy KL - Public Complaints and accompanying administrative regulation.
