Communicable Diseases – Students

The district shall comply with state law and rules and state and local health authorities' guidelines regarding communicable diseases.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations as needed to implement this policy to reduce the risk of contagion in the school setting.

The district will include, as a part of its emergency plan, a description of the actions to be taken by district personnel in the case of a declared public health emergency or other catastrophe that disrupts district operations.
