Superintendent

The position of superintendent is of greatest importance to a district. The Board believes that a successful superintendent will have exceptional qualities of leadership and responsibility, flexibility, decision making, judgment and perception, ability under pressure, a forthright positive attitude and high moral character.

Specifically the superintendent shall hold a valid Oregon superintendent's license and have a master's or higher degree with a background in school administration, curriculum and supervision or a transitional administrator or exceptional administrator license, upon joint application of the prospective superintendent and Board chairman with Teacher Standards and Practices Commission approval. The superintendent shall have former successful administrative experience, a strong general education background and a minimum of three years successful teaching experience or similar related experience.

The superintendent is the chief executive officer of the district and has, under the Board's direction, general supervision of all district schools, personnel and departments. The superintendent is responsible for managing the schools under the Board's policies and is accountable to the Board for that management.

The superintendent may delegate to other district personnel any powers and duties imposed upon the superintendent by Board policies or by vote of the Board. Delegation of power or duty, however, will not relieve the superintendent of responsibility for action taken under such delegation.
