Temporary School Facilities

Because rented facilities, relocatable units and other emergency school housing may be inadequate for long-term school purposes, it is the aim of the Board to have sufficient permanent facilities to meet the needs of school enrollment and the district program.

If circumstances require immediate space not available in district buildings, facilities will be rented and/or relocatable structures used only as a temporary measure. Any such facility must conform to all appropriate state and local building and land use codes, health and fire laws, environmental standards and usability as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
