Volunteers

School Volunteers

Building principals oversee the recruitment, assignment and supervision of school volunteers. These volunteer arrangements may be short term such as a one day field trip. Other activities such as lunch room service may be long term. School principals are in charge of this type of volunteer help; no Board action is required.

Volunteer Coaches

Before practices begin and before prospective volunteers are allowed on the playing field, on the bench or in the locker room: 1) head coaches must meet with the school principal to discuss and plan the use of volunteers, present a roster of persons who are interested, their qualifications and expected role; 2) the principal will then bring recommendations to the Board for approval.

Coaching positions are extra duty assignments which routinely go to the Board for approval of both (1) the hiree and (2) the stipend (if any is to be paid). Both paid and unpaid volunteer coaches must have Board approval.

Other Volunteers

Many volunteers assist with extracurricular activities including dance chaperones, statisticians for games and rooter bus chaperones. All of these are directly supervised by the school principal and do not come before the Board for approval.

Does the School District Fingerprint Every Volunteer?

The district does Oregon criminal history checks on all volunteers but does not fingerprint.

How Much Do We Appreciate Volunteers?

More than can be expressed. Volunteers provide countless hours of service. Orientation meetings will be held in the fall of each year with specific dates and times to be posted in the calendar letter.
