Grading System

The district's grading system shall be based on Board-adopted course content and is designed to enable the student and parent to clearly know how well the student is achieving course requirements.

Grading will be on a nine-week basis. The nine-week grade will be based on many factors, such as: basal text assignments, both oral and written; class participation; special assignments; research; activities of various types and kinds; special contributions.

Although it may be difficult to establish the quality of grades and the methods used in arriving at a grade, there must be a record which reveals how the teacher arrived at the grades given.

At the beginning of the grading period students and parents will be informed regarding the basis of the grades and the methods to be used in determining them.
