Academic Integrity

The Board believes that students are expected to put forth their best effort on tests and assignments. Engaging in various forms of cheating or academic dishonesty does not permit students to realize the full extent of the educational experience or their full academic potential.

Students are encouraged to converse with others and assist other students when it is in a manner that is not inconsistent with testing or assignment instructions. Assisting others is prohibited, however, when it would constitute academic dishonesty. Prohibited events include, but are not limited to:

1. Using or sharing prohibited study aides or other written materials on tests or assignment.
2. Sharing, collaborating or communicating with others on tests or assignments, in violation of directions by the class instructor.
3. Knowingly sharing false information or knowingly misleading another to reach a false answer or conclusion.
4. Deliberately underperform on tests or assignments.

Violation of this policy may result in discipline as deemed appropriate by the instructor or administration, based on the nature and seriousness of the offense. Discipline may involve the district prohibiting the student from participating in school-sponsored activities or events; denial or revocation of school-conferred titles, distinctions, honors or privileges; or suspension or expulsion.
