## Assessment Programs\*\*

The Board supports the use of standardized tests as one indication of the success and quality of the educational program. In the case of individual students, standardized tests, in combination with other criteria, can provide an indication of student achievement.

The Board will, therefore:

1. Provide for an ongoing standardized assessment program which will be subject to regular review and evaluation;
2. Require careful evaluation of all proposed assessment instruments and periodic evaluation of the results;
3. Provide for the in-service of teachers and other staff members in the use of standardized tests and interpretation of test results.

In keeping with State Board of Education requirements, the district will annually administer statewide benchmarks in grades 3, 5 8 and 10.

Test results will be reported to parents. Cumulative test results will be reported to the public.
