Staff/Student/Parent Relations**

The Board believes it is appropriate to assure students have frequent and continuing contact with and support from parents. In concert with that belief, the Board directs the administration to make all reasonable attempts to encourage parents in the rights and responsibilities of their student.

Further, the Board encourages both parents to be involved in their student's school affairs, and unless otherwise ordered by the courts, an order of sole custody to one parent shall not deprive the other parent access to the student's education records.

The parent having sole custody will be contacted before records are released to a non-custodial parent. Only if the parent having sole custody presents a court document to the contrary will the non-custodial parent be denied access to the records.

The noncustodial parent may receive and inspect their student's education records and consult with school staff concerning the student's welfare and education to the same extent as provided the parent having sole custody.

Noncustodial parents will not be granted visitation or telephone access to the student during the school day nor will a student be released to the noncustodial parent without written permission of the parent having sole custody.
