Research

If an employee plans to engage in an educational research project during the work day or use school resources or students either for study toward advanced work or for use in classroom instruction, approval must be secured from the superintendent. If the study results in material which would be useful to other employees, it shall be made available for distribution throughout the district. For the protection of all concerned, privacy rights of students or other individuals involved in research projects must be protected.

Research of this nature which is conducted by or for a non-district employee must be approved by the superintendent.
