

Use of Feature Films/Videos in the School**

Prior to showing a feature film/video in a school, the instructor must seek the written approval of the principal. At least five days prior to the showing, the instructor shall submit to the principal (in writing) the following information on the particular film:

1. Title and brief description;
2. Purpose for the showing;
3. Match with course objectives and state standards;
4. Proposed date of showing;
5. How parental consent will be obtained and times for parent preview;
6. Audience rating (G, PG, PG-13, R); and
7. Written confirmation that instructors have previewed all films media in its entirety before showing to students.

Additionally, for feature films/videos with a PG (Grades K-6), PG-13 (Grades 7-9) and R (Grades 10-12) rating, prior parental consent will be required before a student views the film.

A parent may have the opportunity to preview a film when practicably possible.

Student or other non commercially created media and edited or unrated films/videos will be shown at the discretion of the building administrator.
